26. brief description (note unusual features, integrity, environment, threats and associated buildings) <p>This is a 2 1/2 story brick and half-timbered house, basically an ell shape with a formal facade on the E elevation. Surrounded by a large lawn, it is sited opposite the 2nd hole of the Allegheny Country Club golf course.</p> <p>The slate covered gable roof is pierced by 7 chimneys, decoratively corbelled and capped by ceramic pots. Shed dormers project on W elevations.</p> <p>Windows are predominantly d/s (6/6) with some casement windows of varying sizes. Bay windows project on W.</p> <p>The E and W elevations feature gable dormers asymmetrically arranged. Bargeboards have pendants, and gable ends are stucco and vertical timbering. A French door is centered on the E elevation beneath an arched portico. A projecting gable bay on the N end of this elevation contains a series of arched French doors on the first story. The main entrance, located on the W side, is sheltered by a portico.</p> <p>Associated buildings: Garage to the NW (see (cont.)) (continue on back if necessary)</p>				
27. history, significance and/or background <p>Formerly, this was the home of J. F. Byers. It is currently owned by H. J. Heinz, II of the Pittsburgh-based H. J. Heinz Company, a leader in the food products industry.</p>
